On the third Sunday in November, 1956, the first Service was held in our new Church building. First, we thanked our Lord, who had ministered, guided, and kept us together in one Spirit to do His Will. We wanted to thank everyone who had given of money, time, effort, timber and the actual labor in building the Church. The Church furnishings were supplied by members and as memorials of former members and loved ones.

Dedication services were held on the second day of December, 1956, one year after the Church building had burned.

On October 30, 1957, the entire debt on the new Church was paid off and the note burned. We were so very thankful to God.

Since that time, Shiloh has been blessed with leadership and resources to make many improvements to the building, and in our programs, including a substantial increase in our Missions Programs.

## SOMERVILLE FEMALE INSTITUTE

Somerville Female Institute was established in Leasburg, N.C. by the Rev. Solomon Lea in 1848. It remained in operation until 1892. The name of the school was derived from a noted astronomer, Mary Somerville, whose work Mr. Lea admired. Besides himself, other teachers in the school included his wife, the former Miss Sophia Ainger of England, Miss Sarah Stanfield, Miss Margaret Harrison and a Miss French, who was from Vermont.

This school attracted scores of young girls from North Carolina, Virginia and some other southern states. Subjects taught included Grammar, Arithmetic, Algebra, Latin, French Dictionary, Philosophy, Botany, Chemistry, Geography, Astronomy, Rhetoric, Reading, Moral Science and Music. Materials furnished to pupils were slates, penholders, inkwells, envelopes and fine paper.

From an account book that included the

Scores of girls were educated at Somerville Institute. From the account book, many accounts were settled by a load or two of wood, a sack of flour or potatoes or the use of a team of horses. Solomon Lea, his wife, and his daughters taught in the school. It remained in operation until Mr. Lea's health failed in 1892.

Solomon Lea graduated from the University of North Carolina in 1833 but his penmanship was sometimes difficult to decipher. Some of the girls names are probably misspelled.
